### **3 Momentous Canadian Stamp Collecting You Need to Know**

Since its inception on May 6, 1840, "postage stamps" had been a part of history as it unfolds the greatest line of creations that the society is enjoying up to this day.

By the time the postage stamps were created, the idea of collecting them came into view right after they were circulated in the market. This is because some people have grown fondness with these artistic creations that they have decided to collect them.

For this reason, stamp manufacturers in Canada had realized the values that stamps could bring. That is why they have decided to make their own stamps. These stamps were previously created to reflect the historical background of Canada.

From the well-known maple leaf coin down to the historical stamps, Canada has remarkably created a culture of its own, with the stamps and the coins as emblems of pure classiness.

Since then, Canadian stamp collecting started. From the commonly used stamps up to those that are classified as rare and hard to find, stamp collecting in Canada is definitely a rewarding hobby.

So if you are a Canadian citizen and is interested in starting a Canadian stamp collecting, there are a few pointers that you need to know first before you start collecting those miniature masterpieces:

#### **1. The ability to sort stamps**

Every stamp collector, whether a Canadian or not, should learn how to sort different kinds of stamps. It would be better to sort them first before you keep them in your album for record keeping.

The sorting process will be based on the stamp collecting that you are interested in. For instance, if you want to collect stamps by topic, say, historical facts, start from there.

You can even sort them according to their classifications like you could separate the special delivery stamps to those of the revenue stamps, and the list will go on.

#### **2. Learn how to remove stamps in the envelope without damaging them**

If you have decided to start Canadian stamp collecting, it is extremely important that you know how to peel off those stamps from the envelopes without damaging even the slightest corner of the stamp.

To do this, you must learn the proper way of soaking. In this process, you will be able to peel off the stamp without any damage.

This is relatively easy because all you have to do is to cut the portion where the stamp is placed, taking extra care not to cut the stamp itself. Then, soak them in a basin of water, side up. It would be better if you will use some tepid water, not hot, as this will ruin your stamps.

Do not be in a hurry when soaking stamps because you might have the propensity to soak too many stamps in one just batch. The idea here is to have the stamps extra room to drift above the surface of the water. Once they begin to resurface, try to pull them out carefully and then peel them off once you can sense that they are already to be detached from the paper. Remove any traces of adhesives at the back, then, place them in between "two paper towels" to dry.

Also, keep in mind that if you have a myriad of stamps to soak, try to change the water every two sets so as to ensure that the stamps would be faster to peel off. To save more time and to preserve any identifiable marks within the envelope, it is best to keep the stamps as it is placed in the envelope. This will make your stamp collecting more interesting.

### **3. Use the right mounting tools**

The next thing to learn is on how to place your stamps in the album. It is definitely a big NO-NO to place your stamps in the album using a glue or whatever adhesives that you have.

The ideal way is to have them mounted or hinged. The choice is yours, but either of the two will do. These are available from any stamp dealers in your community. Just try to choose the ones that will work best for your collections.

All of these things are boiled down to the fact that starting a Canadian stamp collection is never complicated once you know these three pointers by heart. The idea of stamp collecting is to keep all your stuff organized. Once you have familiarized yourself with Canadian stamp collecting, you are definitely on your way to a gratifying pastime.

### First Day Covers

Also known as the FDC's, these are envelopes with stamps that were cancelled on the day the stamp was issued.

It becomes more challenging as they take on the search for specific stamps. Often, this challenge makes the collector desire for more.

### **Aiming for More**

To satisfy this desire for more, it is necessary that the collector know all the details of the stamps. The most useful tool to use here is the stamp catalogue. This could showcase the stamps of a particular region or even worldwide coverage. It provides stamp details such as the official name, date of issuance, material, face value and actual value.

The value of a stamp is often determined by the conditions of its issuance. Most stamps are for ordinary release. The valuable ones are those that came out in a very limited edition. They can be very rare and hard-to-find, making their market value very high.

Take a particular place in United States, the Channel Island for example. The postage service in the locality of Channel Island will usually provide ordinary stamps for mail purposes of the citizens.

However, every now and then, the postage service may release a special commemoration stamp. This may commemorate an event or a figure very special to Channel Island. The Channel Island for example has a special Channel Island 1940-45 Occupation Stamp.

It tells a lot about the history of Channel Island. Thus, it is also very much expected that the residents of Channel Island will especially aim for that and more.

There are many stamp collectors out there, millions actually, who have different goals and aims in pursuing their hobby. They may have a different history, origin and languages. Still, the very same hobby unites them all as they share the same sentiments and love for collecting stamps.

### **Why Not Join a Chicago Stamp Collecting Club?**

There are stamps in singles for those who want to limit the budget. There are also inexpensive ones consisting of the older or cancelled US postage stamps. They do hold a visual quality. Blocks of stamps of barely cancelled type are a considerable addition to the collection.

Here, everyone can exchange tips on how to take care of the stamps, learn something new or even explore together into a research.

Another fact that proves how much the residents of Kentucky value stamp collecting is that they have a gallery dedicated to it. The Dupont Stamp Studio of Kentucky is very well-known to lovers of stamp collecting.

The many wonders that a stamp can bring cannot be denied. It is no surprise that a considerable population of Louisville, Kentucky are very much fascinated with the hobby. Stamp collecting is very likely to flourish still in the near future even if people tend to send less snail mails. It may even get more exciting given the number of dedicated stamp collectors out there.

### **A Stamp-eede in San Antonio!**

San Antonio, Texas, is just one of the many places worldwide that is hooked on the more-than-century-old craze of philately: the study of stamps, and stamp collecting. It had its beginnings alongside the national consolidation of stamp collectors and enthusiasts.

This consolidation happened when stamp collectors and enthusiasts all over the United States gathered together in the year 1886 to create the American Philatelic Society (APS). Fuelled by the same keen interest exuded by its present-day members, it is home to the largest congregation of stamp collectors worldwide.

To date, the APS has more than 44, 000 members. Because APS is a non-profit organization, the APS has been kept alive by years of continued donation and patronage from its sponsors, marginal revenue (almost like a donation) from the philatelic services they provide, and the receipt of the members' dues.

In the APS level, the organization aims to promote stamp collecting, devise innovative ways and programs to better enhance the benefit acquired by stamp collectors, to offer philatelic services both to avid stamp collectors and the general public, and to assist their members in the exchange or disposal of stamps in their collections. Their continued growth of the American philatelist community is fostered by the various activities spearheaded by the APS.

The APS chapter in San Antonio, Texas goes by the name of the San Antonio Philatelic Association (SAPA). Formed in the year 1896, the SAPA is in fact a life member of APS and the umbrella of the Texas Philatelic Association. It is labeled APS Chapter #388, and as Texas Philatelic Chapter #3. At present, the chapter has over a 130 members participating in their various activities. They even allow juniors, who are between the ages of 12 and 18, to participate in the SAPA when they have at least a sponsoring parent acting on their behalf.

In the year 1996, the SAPA organized a stamp show in order to celebrate the centennial it shares with the Texas Philatelic Association. Labeled TEXPEX 1996, it debuted the first new reprints of coil stamps in the country.

In fact, the beginnings of the Texan obsession with stamps began in San Antonio. Alongside the creation of the SAPA was the creation of the Texas Philatelic Association (TPA), the umbrella organization under which various philatelic groups in the state of Texas are affiliated to. To

date, the Texas Philatelic Association is one of the oldest philatelic associations in the country that continues its operations even in the present day.

Its foundation, called the TPA foundation, was certified as a Texas Non-Profit Foundation, Inc. in the year 1975. This was created in order to encourage the study and research on philately through the creation of libraries, laboratories, and to afford research grants and scholarships. The cost of research may be reimbursed once the grant is made to publish any and all study the foundation finds fit.

Membership in the TPA subsequently means a lifetime membership to the APS (as membership in SAPA translates to a life membership with TPA and APS). This membership affords various benefits for philatelic enthusiasts, which include the receipt of the bi-monthly official publication, the Texas Philatelist. This publication covers regular columns, list of upcoming events of TPA and other affiliate chapters, and feature articles of interest to philatelists particularly in the Texas area.

Membership also helps members take steps toward the acquisition of much-desired stamps the TPA allows for free advertising of "want ads" on the TPA, as well as facilitate auctions for the sale and purchase of stamps between and among members. The association also helps members, particularly those of similar philatelic interests, to get together through the directory of members they provide. Being a member means invitation to TEXPEX, the annual convention-cum-exhibition held annually in Dallas. It also means access to information and answers to queries that may be provided by expert-philatelists also affiliated to TPA.

Like the SAPA, the TPA allows memberships for individuals aged 18 and above. Junior membership is also available for those under the age of 18 but with parents who will sponsor their participation. Membership in TPA is not, in any way, geographically limited to Texas alone.

The San Antonio Philatelic Association continues to be an active member of both the APS and the TPA. Unlike other stamp clubs, the SAPA takes pride in the fact that it remains to be one of the few clubs that meet consistently every week. Meetings of the San Antonio Philatelic Association are held at St. Luke's Lutheran Church in Santa Monica, San Antonio, Texas on Fridays at 7:30 PM.

For each Friday of the month, there is a pre-assigned agenda for the club; the first dedicated to a business meeting and presentation of the members. The second Friday is, on the other hand, dedicated for stamp auctions, while the third Friday is for a program organized by the members of the club. The fourth Friday of the month, finally, is dedicated to stamp bourse.

In order to help all the members keep up to date on events and happenings in the club, the San Antonio Philatelic Association issues a bi-monthly newsletter called The Philatex.

### **3 Tips on How to Start Coin and Stamp Collecting in Torrance**

It is for this reason that Torrance had given so much importance in producing stamps and coins to preserve anything and everything that was left for the people of Torrance to cherish and appreciate.

In turn, many people in Torrance were lured to try stamp and coin collecting. They know that with the richness of their city's culture and history, these kinds of hobbies are not just mere diversions but may provide profitable ventures as well.

However, starting a coin and stamp collecting in Torrance may not be as easy as 1-2-3, but they are not that difficult as well. This only means that in order for a collector wannabe to succeed in his chosen venture, he must learn some factors that may affect the status of his undertaking.

Here is how:

#### **1. Educate yourself**

Starting a stamp and coin collecting in Torrance would never be easy if the person concerned will not take extra effort of researching and educating himself about the hobby itself and about his place, Torrance.
